## **Membership Commitment**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, commit to membership in the Prince George – Norwich Meadows Farm CSA for the 2010 harvest season. By filling out and signing this form you will become a partner for the growing season with Norwich Meadows Farm. In addition, I commit myself to pick up my weekly delivery of produce at The Prince George, located at 14 East 28<sup>th</sup> Street. **I understand that if I do not pick up my share it will be donated to City Harvest and no refund will be made.** *In the event of an emergency ONLY your share can be saved. However, you must notify the CSA coordinators 24hrs in advance.* Please note that if you order other products and you **DO NOT** pick them up on the distribution day we will **NOT** save them and no refund will be made to you for those missed products. I understand that if I choose to forfeit my share I will not receive a refund for the total cost of my share including other products. I also understand that I am expected to give a minimum of (2) hours of volunteer time to the CSA over the course of the growing season (June –November).

## **The CSA Share**

As a member of the CSA, I will choose to receive either a weekly family share or a weekly individual share. The shares will vary in size and weight depending on the time of the season. Members support their farmer by sharing in the inherent risks of agriculture (poor weather, drought, disease, early frost, crop failure and so on) and rewards (the bounty from a good season) involved in farming. CSA farmers purposely plan for such contingencies, and use growing techniques that protect the harvest, minimize risk to members, and optimize the rewards. On the whole, members will get a wide variety of vegetables in plentiful amounts.

I understand this principle and agree that there is no guarantee on the *exact* amount or type of produce I will receive in my share. By participating in the CSA, I am supporting the local farmer as well as more equitable food distribution and I am helping to create a more environmentally just, economically fair and healthy society.

## **Share Cost**

Share cost is based on **household** income. Prices will vary according to the income bracket each member fits into. Higher income members pay slightly more in order to subsidize shares for those who fit into the lower income bracket. All members receive the same size share.
