The Brownsville Partnership can help you and your family:

- Avoid eviction and address rental arrears
- Access free legal services for housing-related issues and free financial counseling through the Single Stop program
- Ensure the health and development of pregnant women, babies and toddlers through the Nurse-Family Partnership program, Parent-Child Home program, and Baby & Me playgroups
- Access educational opportunities, including Pre-GED, GED and ESL classes
- Learn about job training programs
- Search for employment, create a resume, prepare for interviews and excel on the job
- Obtain health care advice and referrals
- Enroll in afterschool and recreational activities, including sports, music and the arts
